Tour Stop Details

1	Pier 39	Home to San Francisco's famous sea lions.
2	Pier 41	Great view of Alcatraz and Angel Islands
3	Boudin	Sourdough bread made just like during the Gold Rush of 1849
4	Crab Stands	San Francisco seafood served here since the 1920's
5	Red & White Fleet	Started by a 17-year-old San Franciscan with a used rowboat.
6	Historic War Ships	One of the few remaining WWII submarine and Liberty ship on view to the public.
7	Fishing Fleet	The historic and future heart of Fisherman's Wharf.
8	The Cannery	This revitalized fruit canning plant is still an important part of Fisherman's Wharf.
9	Hyde St Pier	Learn the reality behind old-time sailing ships.
10	South End Rowing Club	Some of its earliest members used their rowing skills for less-than-honest work.
11	Cable Cars	Invented in San Francisco and loved by all.
12	Ghirardelli Square	A great place to indulge your sweet tooth.
13	Maritime Museum	A small art deco building that is the jewel of the San Francisco Aquatic Park.
14	Aquatic Park	The best place in town to go swimming in the cold waters of San Francisco Bay.
15	Municipal Pier	See if the fish are biting as you view the Golden Gate Bridge.
