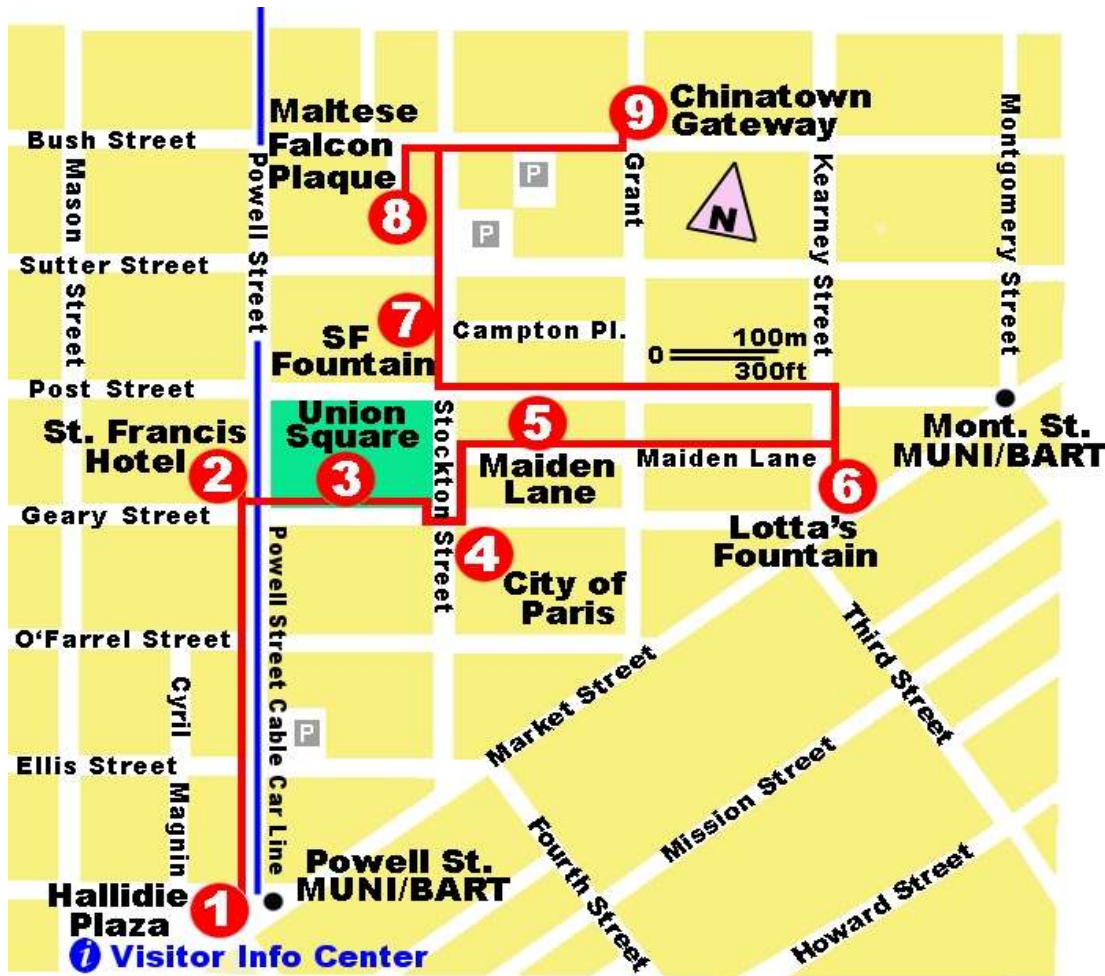


# Geogad Mobile Tour of San Francisco Union Square

## Tour Stop Details

1	Hallidie Plaza	Named after the inventor of the cable car, Hallidie Plaza is the terminus for the Powell Cable Car Line.
2	St. Francis Hotel	One of the grandest hotels before, during and after the Great Earthquake of 1906.
3	Union Square	Named during the U.S. Civil War, Union Square has been surrounded by great shopping almost from its start.
4	City of Paris	Even though the original City of Paris store is gone, it still lives on.
5	Maiden Lane	Its modest name was chosen to hide the immodest history of this small street.
6	Lotta's Fountain	The place to be on the anniversary of the Great Earthquake of 1906.
7	SF Fountain	This artistic sculpture shows the many sides and impressions of San Francisco.
8	Maltese Falcon Plaque	Follow in the footsteps of San Francisco's toughest literary detective, Sam Spade.
9	Chinatown	One of San Francisco's smallest but much beloved neighborhoods.
